While working in the above capacities for more than two decades, my general duties and responsibilities were:-

1. Management of Bio-Diversity rich tropical forests of Kerala for their ecological and economic functions.
2. Raising quality plantations of forestry species, especially Teak and other pulpwood, species to meet the ever increasing demand of wood, both by industry and common man.
3. Establishment of Central Forest nurseries and production of quality nursery stock required for raising productive forest plantations.
4. Administration of external aided Kerala forestry project funded by World Bank.
5. Organization of State, National and International level seminars, workshops etc.
6. Management of Human Resources in the Forest Department
7. Plantation activities outside the Reserve Forest, i.e. private and public land.
8. Management of wildlife.

(4) While working in Kerala cadre, I was on deputation to College of Forestry, Kerala Agricultural University in the capacity of Associate Dean for almost one year. During this period, I was involved in forestry education, Research and Extension.

(5) I was also on deputation to Institute of Wood Science and Technology, Bangalore, a subsidiary of Indian Council of Forest Research & Education, Ministry of Environment & Forest, Govt. of India during 1994-96. In this Institute, I was in-charge of research planning and administration.

(6) While working in Kerala cadre from 3.10.2006 to 3.10.2011, I was on deputation to Department of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of Kerala. During this period, I was working as Managing Director, OUSHADHI, a Govt. of Kerala Pharmaceutical Corporation, involved in

As Joint Secretary in the Department of Health Research. I was involved in discharge of all the above functions.

(9) I have also served as Member Secretary, Central Silk Board, Ministry of Textiles, Government of India, Bengaluru from 15.06.2015 to 15.05.2017. Member Secretary is the Chief Executive Officer of Central Silk Board (CSB). In this capacity, my duty involved planning of sericultural development programmes, implementing the Central Sector Schemes, monitoring implementation of sericulture development schemes, supervision of research programmes, nucleus and basic silkworm seed production and supply, quality improvement at all stages of silk production, personnel management, coordination with State Governments and other stakeholders, collaboration with international agencies connected with sericulture etc. Duties also include administration of CSB which has about 3300 personnel spread over 325 locations in India. The objectives of the position was also to direct the development of sericulture and silk industry in the country in coordination with the State Governments and simultaneously address Govt. of India's development priorities related to growth of rural economy, poverty alleviation and women empowerment using silk industry as an important tool. I am also responsible for furnishing periodical reports to the Ministry, Planning Commission and Parliament regarding the functioning of Central Silk Board and development of silk industry.

During this period I have also worked as Secretary General of International Sericulture Commission. As Secretary General (ISC), I was also involved in promotion of sericulture across the globe, specially in member countries of ISC.

(10) Presently I am working as Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Head of Forest Force (PCCF & HoFF) in Kerala Forest Department from 01.08.2017. As PCCF & HoFF my duties include implementation of various Central & State schemes for the Conservation & Protection of Bio-diversity rich forest resources of State; management of forest plantations; the promotion of forestry research & education, and Management of Human Resources of the department.
